

Joshua Alain Bouillon - Biography

Franco-American tenor, **Joshua Alain Bouillon**, is rapidly emerging as a diversified, in-demand singer. Giving commanding, powerful and honest performances, Mr. Bouillon is growing in reputation as a recitalist, in concert and on the opera stage. Recent concert work includes *Mass in E-flat* by Amy Beach with [Rochester Oratorio Society](#) and Handel's *Messiah* with the South Dakota Symphony Orchestra. Recent operatic roles include Roméo in Gounod's *Roméo et Juliette* with [Maryland Lyric Opera](#) and Gontran in *Une Education Manquée* by Chabrier with [Rochester Lyric Opera](#).

In the summer of 2013 he made his European debut singing Don Ottavio in Mozart's *Don Giovanni* at the [Crescendo Summer Institute](#) in Sárospatak, Hungary - a production that was broadcasted on national television. As a young artist, Mr. Bouillon has participated in a number of festivals and artist programs including [Opera Colorado](#), Green Mountain Opera Festival, and [Opera North](#). In the spring of 2016, he placed third in the ROS [Classical Idol competition](#). He holds a Bachelor of Music from Liberty University and a Masters of Music from the Eastman School of Music.
