Democrat and Chronicle education journalist Justin Murphy will discuss how the nationwide Great Migration of African-Americans from the South to the North throughout the 20th century manifested in Rochester, how those migrants were greeted and how they changed the face of the community forever. The research comes from Murphy's forthcoming book on the history of school segregation in Rochester.

Justin Murphy is the education reporter at the *Democrat and Chronicle*, where he has worked since 2012. Before that was a reporter for *The Citizen* in Auburn, New York. He grew up in Penfield and attended the University of Chicago and the S.I. Newhouse School of Public Communications at Syracuse University. He is currently writing a book about the history of school segregation in Rochester.
