Driving Directions to Roberts Wesleyan College:

From the North, take 390S to 490W. Exit 4, turn right/north on 259/Union St. About 2 miles up, turn right onto 33/Buffalo Rd. The college entrance will be on the left.

From the South, take 390N to 490W. Exit 4, turn right/north on 259/Union St. About 2 miles up, turn right onto 33/Buffalo Rd. The college entrance will be on the left.

From the East, take 490W to Exit 4, turn right/north on 259/Union St. About 2 miles up, turn right onto 33/Buffalo Rd.

From the West, take 490E to Exit 4, turn left/north on 259/Union St. About 2 miles up, turn right onto 33/Buffalo Rd. The college entrance will be on the left.

CONSULTATION

WPS provides consultative services with outside providers and school personnel that include training development and collaborative support for school systems or organizations.

FEES

Therapy: Cost is dependent on the clinician's level of training/licensure.

Evaluations and Consultation: Cost is dependent on the complexity of the referral question or the training provided.
