

Thank you for visiting Roberts Wesleyan College!

Your safety is our priority. We are using the best information available to ensure the health of our students, faculty, staff, and visitors. Here is what you can expect during your visit to Roberts.

We are currently offering private tour highlights and appointments for up to 4 total visitors from the same family group at a time.

All of the staff, students, and faculty you interact with during your visit will be wearing face coverings. All visitors must also wear a face covering that completely covers the nose and mouth at all times while on campus, including when outdoors.

We will maintain 6' physical distancing during your visit. Hand sanitizing stations are available throughout campus.

When you arrive, your admissions counselor will welcome you at your car, take your temperature and complete an arrival screening which will include the following questions:

1. Do you feel well today?
2. Have you had any of the following symptoms in the past 24 hours, which are not typical?
 - Temperature of 100F or higher
 - new cough or new shortness of breath
 - fatigue
 - hard time breathing
 - sore throat
 - body aches
 - headaches
 - chills
 - congestion or runny nose
 - nausea or vomiting
 - diarrhea
 - pain or pressure in the chest that doesn't go away
 - confusion or trouble waking up
 - bluish lips or face

- loss of taste or smell

3. In the last 10 days, have you tested positive for COVID-19, OR have you been in contact with anyone with a confirmed or suspected diagnosis of COVID-19, OR been in close contact with a person being evaluated for COVID-19 without recommended PPE, OR been ordered to self-quarantine? (*"Close contact" is defined as within 6 feet of an infected person for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period*).

4. In the last 14 days, have you traveled outside the US? If yes, did you receive results of a negative Covid-19 test administered four days after your return to New York?
