

COVID Quick Guide

Early Childhood Music - Fall 2021

1. All adults and children over two (2) years of age must be masked while attending class.

Per campus regulations, all individuals over two (2) years of age must be fully masked when inside campus buildings. Individuals who refuse to comply with the masking requirements will be asked to leave.

2. All efforts will be made to maintain social distancing of at least 3 feet between family groups.

Although the campus does not require social distancing at this time, class sizes will remain small to ensure adequate space for families to socially distance as a unit. In the event that enrollment increases, we may ask that only one caregiver attend classes to allow for as much space as possible for each family. Please understand that this is to maintain the safety of students who are unable to be vaccinated at this time.

3. All materials, both individual and shared, will be sanitized following every class.

To limit the sharing of materials, each child will receive a bag of instruments and movement tools to use for the duration of the term. At the end of class, these materials will be collected and sanitized appropriately.

4. Sharing of materials will be limited to equipment that is easily sanitized.

Additional instruments and tools may be included during class and shared between students. If this is the case, hand sanitizer will be used before children take their turn. The instructor will bring a spray-based sanitizer. Caregivers may bring their own to use if they prefer. In addition, the instrument will be sanitized at the end of the class prior to storage.

5. Children or adults who are showing signs of illness (i.e.; runny nose, cough, fever, etc.) should remain home.

If a child or adult seems unwell, the instructor reserves the right to ask them to leave class for the week. This is to protect the health and well-being of the other children in attendance.

In the event of the need for a family to quarantine, we still want to make class available. Therefore, a Zoom link will be provided every Friday so families can participate in class from home on Saturday mornings. If a family decides to Zoom, we ask that you logon 10 minutes prior to the start of class to make simultaneous instruction run more smoothly.
