The American Rescue Plan (ARP) was signed into law on March 11, 2021 by President Biden. The Plan created a third Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund ("HEERF III") for distribution to colleges and universities, intended to help offset costs to students and institutions resulting from campus disruptions due to the Coronavirus. This report is required by Section 314(e) of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) and is published here pursuant to the guidance issued by the U.S. Department of Education.

Roberts Wesleyan College signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants for Students under the Act on April 24, 2020.

The College received \$1,954,761 from the American Rescue Plan for direct to student grants. This funding was distributed based on the unique needs of our student population. The allocations to groups of students are described below.

Between October 1, 2021 and December 31, 2021, \$1,410,331 in Emergency Financial Aid Grants have been distributed to students under ARP/HEERF III.

The estimated total number of students at the institution eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students is 1,800.

The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under ARP/HEERF III as of the date of this report is 389.

The methods used by Roberts Wesleyan College to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they receive under Section 314(a)(1) of the ARP/HEERF III are determined by a student's application attesting to their financial needs.
