

NC-SARA Licensed Profession Program Disclosures (Distance Education Programs)

Federal regulation requires all schools to disclose information to admitted students about their degree programs if the degree is advertised as leading to a professional license. Per U.S. Federal Regulations, §668.43 (2019 Rule), and in compliance with the State Authorization Reciprocity Agreements (SARA) Manual version 22.1, Roberts Wesleyan College provides the following information for distance education programs which may lead to professional licensure or certification.
