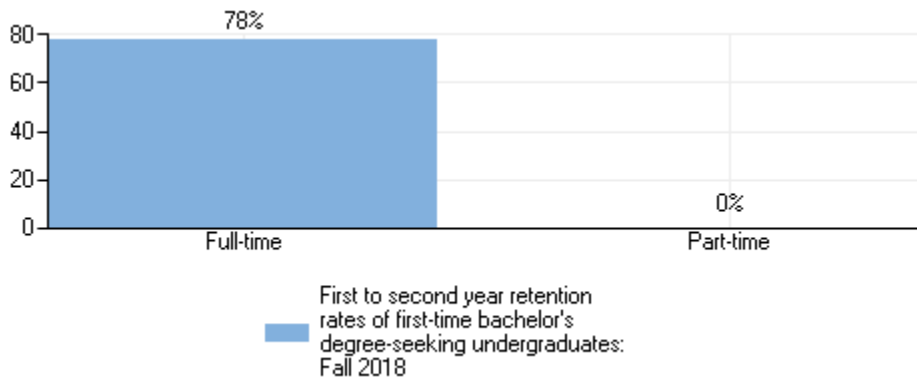
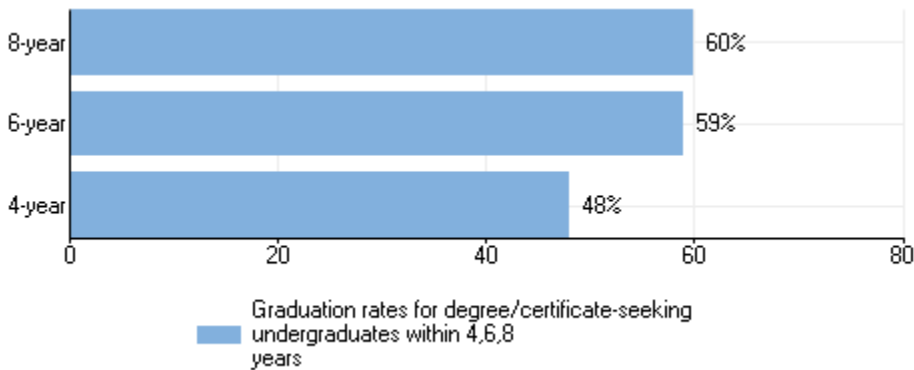


First to second year retention rates of first-time bachelor's degree-seeking undergraduates: Fall 2018
