\*\* The "Total Estimated Cost" may not be the same as the final required payment by the individual student. Required payment amounts are based on several individual factors—including, for example, one's state and federal aid or specific program requirements.

\*\*\* The "Off-Campus Enrichment Scholarship" replaces all institutional aid for the semester a student is studying abroad. In most cases, State & Federal Aid and all non-RWC scholarships are still applicable. In cases where the semester abroad is required for the program, additional institutional aid may be awarded.

\*\*\*\*Personal expenses do NOT appear on the student bill and are not covered by financial aid. These are additional estimates for out-of-pocket expenses that students should anticipate as part of a study abroad and travel experience. **NOTE:** Board for this program is billed for Monday-Thursday only. Students are expected to cover their own meals from Friday-Sunday. This cost is factored into "Additional Board" in the Personal Expenses column.

### About Austria:

Primary Language: German (many Europeans are also fluent in English)

Climate: Temperate. Salzburg is warmer in winter and cooler in summer than Rochester.

Currency: Euro (approximate exchange \$1 = €0.89)

Cost of Living: Slightly higher than US

Traveling: Safe & easy. Salzburg has an efficient bus system, & Europe has easy, inexpensive public transportation .
