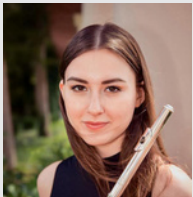
MUSIC EDUCATION

STUDENT SPOTLIGHTS



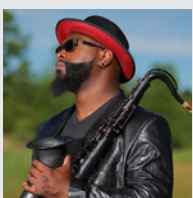
