1. Apply to Roberts
2. Fill Out FAFSA & TAP
Our FAFSA school code is: 002805
3. Become Accepted and Receive Your Offer Letter from Roberts
You'll receive your *Financial Aid Offer Letter*, which covers your scholarships, grants, and loan opportunities.
4. Accept Your Financial Aid Through the Financial Aid Portal
Check the "*To Do List and Financial Aid Messages*" section of the Financial Aid Portal
5. Submit Your Deposit
6. Attend Important Events (Visit Campus, Accepted Students Day, & New Student Registration)
