

# Professional Licensure Disclosure

Roberts Wesleyan University *Effective July 1, 2024 | In accordance with 34 CFR §668.14 and §668.43 | SARA Policy Manual, Version 25.2*

## Purpose and Regulatory Basis

Effective July 1, 2024, federal regulation requires institutions of higher education to determine whether a Title IV eligible academic program that leads to professional licensure or certification meets the educational requirements for licensure or certification in:

- The U.S. state where the institution is located (New York);
- The U.S. states where distance education students are located at the time of initial enrollment;
- U.S. states where the program is advertised as meeting licensure or certification requirements; and
- If applicable, the U.S. state where a student attests they intend to be licensed or certified.

Per U.S. Federal Regulations §668.14 and §668.43, and in compliance with the **SARA Policy Manual (Version 25.2)**, Roberts Wesleyan University provides the following disclosures related to the educational requirements for professional licensure and certification.

## Institutional Commitment to Compliance

Roberts Wesleyan University (RWU) is committed to transparency and regulatory compliance in all matters related to professional licensure and certification. RWU has undertaken a program-by-program review to determine whether its licensure-leading programs meet the educational requirements for licensure or certification in U.S. states and territories where it enrolls or recruits students.

**The responsibility for these determinations rests with Roberts Wesleyan University.** Program-specific determinations — indicating whether RWU's program meets, does not meet, or has not yet been determined to meet the educational requirements for licensure in each state — are provided in the program-specific disclosure tables accessible via the links below.

**Important Note:** A determination of "not yet determined" carries the same practical effect as "does not meet" for purposes of student disclosure and federal financial aid eligibility under 34 CFR §668.14(b)(32).

## New York State

Roberts Wesleyan University's programs leading to professional licensure or certification are carefully designed to meet the educational requirements for licensure and certification in New York State (NYS). RWU's home state authorization is administered through the **New York State Education Department (NYSED)**.

## Other U.S. States and Territories

RWU has made program-specific determinations regarding whether its licensure-leading programs meet the educational requirements for licensure or certification in each U.S. state and territory where it enrolls or recruits students. These determinations are available in the program-specific disclosure tables linked below.

Please note the following:

- RWU's disclosures address **educational requirements only**. Individual licensure decisions — including examination performance, background checks, supervised practice hours beyond academic requirements, and other personal eligibility factors — are made by state licensing boards and are beyond the scope of these institutional disclosures.
  - These disclosures do not guarantee that a state licensure or certification entity will approve or deny any individual application.
  - These disclosures reflect RWU's determinations as of the date indicated. Changes in state law or regulation occurring after a disclosure has been issued may affect licensure requirements, and RWU will update disclosures as such changes become known.

## **Students in States Where a Program Does Not Meet Requirements**

If RWU's program has been determined to not meet — or has not been determined to meet — the educational requirements for licensure or certification in the student's state of residence, the student will receive a direct, individualized disclosure from the University Admissions office prior to or at the time of enrollment. Students in this situation are also required to complete a **Student Attestation of Professional Licensure or Certification** before enrolling.
